The program was founded by Deaf women who experienced firsthand the barriers to communication and support during cancer treatment.

They offer peer support groups (in ASL), educational workshops, advocacy, and direct support services — including care packages for individuals undergoing cancer treatment.

The goal is to help people better understand their diagnosis, navigate treatment, and feel supported throughout their cancer journey.
